



YOU ARE INVITED TO JOIN THE 1930 CLUB

The Bobby Jones Golf Course Foundation is pleased to invite you to join the **1930 Club** at Bobby Jones, a donor program designed to provide access to the course and the private side of the state-of-the-art driving range at the Bobby Jones Golf Course.

Access to the 1930 Club is available for a \$50,000 donation, \$48,000 of which is tax-deductible, payable in cash or stock at one time or in equal installments over the first two years of the five year term. After the initial five-year term, the 1930 Club members may continue access annually for a donation of \$5,000.

1930 Club members enjoy the following special benefits for five years:

1. Tee time access seven days in advance of the general public.
2. Special access to the North Range Tee year-round with complimentary range balls, and to the Georgia State University short game practice area from May 15 to August 15, or when GSU is not using it. Complimentary range balls on the South tee if you prefer not to go to the North tee.
3. One complimentary club fitting. Please contact Jason Kuiper (jason.kuiper@bobbyjoneslinks.com) to schedule.
4. Invitation to an annual St. Patrick's Day donor event.
5. Donor benefits may be assigned or gifted to a family member or associate on an annual basis once per year, with the approval of the Bobby Jones Golf Course Foundation.

Guidelines for Use:

1. Please email Josh Deal (josh.deal@bobbyjoneslinks.com) or Kayla Jones (kayla.jones@bobbyjoneslinks.com) to make advance tee times or let us know when you plan to come out to use the practice facility so we can be prepared for your arrival for practice or play.
2. The North Range Tee will be turf most of the year but may follow the mats/grass schedule of the South Tee to prolong the quality of the turf or keep players out of harm's way.
3. Please use the facilities only during normal business hours and note that the range may be closed for any reason, including maintenance set by BJGC.
4. Golf carts can be taken to the North Tee by 1930 Members if available—if not, a shuttle will be provided on request.
5. BJGC staff may restrict the use of certain clubs on certain days due to safety concerns.
6. Use of the facility is for designated individuals and their families only, if space permits. To ensure donors have access and in keeping with course policy, guests and outside instructors are not permitted.
